Scholarship Criteria and Instructions

Background

The Texas Central Hemophilia Association (TexCen) established the Greg McKinney Memorial Scholarship Program in 2017 to provide support with tuition assistance as our chapter members pursue their education at an accredited college, university, or vocational/technical school.

The scholarship was named in honor of Greg McKinney. Bill and Clara McKinney and their family were active members of the Chapter during its early years, and continue to support the chapter today. Their son Greg was born in 1962 and was diagnosed with severe hemophilia A. Greg was a graduate of Berkner High School in Richardson, attended Richland College and worked for Sears. Greg was diagnosed with HIV in January of 1987 and passed away March 26, 1989.

It is our hope that the individuals who receive this scholarship support will continue to be part of the chapter and provide leadership and support to the bleeding disorders community in the future.

Purpose

The purpose of the scholarship is to support students from the TexCen region living with a bleeding disorder who are pursuing their educational goals by attending an accredited 2 or 4 year college, university or vocational/technical school.

Scholarship Eligibility - In order to be eligible for the award, candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Candidates must be a person with a bleeding disorder OR must have an immediate family member with a bleeding disorder; however, priority will be given to those with bleeding disorders. Immediate family is only considered to be a parent, child, or sibling.
- Candidates must be a member of Texas Central Hemophilia Association and live within our geographic region.
- Candidates must be enrolled in an accredited 2-year or 4-year college/university or vocational/technical institution as a student and be able to provide proof of enrollment.
- Candidates must have an at least a 2.8 on a 4.0 scale.
- Priority will be given to first time applicants.

Application Information

- Type or print all requested information on the application form provided.
- Include a current resume
- Include two (2) letters of recommendation (not by a relative)
- Include a transcript(s)
- Include a 250 word essay on how this scholarship will help you achieve your educational goals.

Application Process

Scholarship will be awarded based on merit, need, community service, and the aspirations of the applicant as reflected in an essay.

The deadline for submitting completed applications is November 1, 2019.

Applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee.

The scholarship will be paid to the school.

Scholarship Award

The \$1500 scholarship for 2019 will be awarded at the Chapter's Winter Education Program on December 7th.
